The University academic year runs from September to June and is divided into two semesters.

Linguistics University of Nizhny Novgorod (LUNN) is a state academic institution accredited by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation. It ranks among the top 4 Russian universities of its kind. LUNN provides education for students who come from all regions of Russia, NIS, Europe, USA and other parts of the world.

LUNN works in close partnership with a number of foreign Universities and other educational establishments. The total number of students at the University, including branches in other locations, is over 3000.

LUNN offers academic programs in language studies, linguistics, translation and interpreting, and humanities at bachelor and master levels. The variety of majors offered include: languages (Russian, German, French, Spanish, Italian, English, Turkish, Chinese, and Japanese) plus a spectrum of humanities (Journalism, Economics, Public Relations, Tourism, Hotel Management, and International Relations).

LUNN is an excellent place for international students where they will find supportive atmosphere for studies and convenient accommodation in the historical and most picturesque part of the city.

Visiting students are invited to enroll either for short-term specialized courses or take up full undergraduate and postgraduate academic programs.

LUNN foreign students are offered comfortable well-equipped single, double or triple rooms in the University dormitory situated next to the University buildings.

A very popular type of accommodation is home stay in Russian families. Some students prefer to stay as paying guests with Russian families, carefully selected by the University.

The home stay program allows a student to experience Russian culture in the warmth, variety, and spontaneity of a Russian home while having excellent, relaxed opportunities to practice spoken Russian.

Full- or half-board (breakfast and/or evening meal) may be arranged upon request.

By sharing meals and interests with the host families, home stay students are expected to live with their hosts as "family members". This means you may be expected to keep your bedroom clean or to help with shared chores, such as washing dishes after a family meal.

LUNN also provides several academic and non-academic facilities and services to students including a library, sport facilities and/or activities, study abroad and exchange programs, online courses and distance learning opportunities, as well as administrative services
